Re: Health System Improvement Act, 2006 (Bill 171)

On July 20, 2007, at a regular Board of Health meeting for Grey Bruce Health Unit, the following motion (#2007-75) was passed:

THAT, the Board of Health endorse the resolution made by the Timiskaming Health Unit regarding the *Health System Improvement Act, 2006 (Bill 171)* which requests 100% provincial funding for a period of time of at least 5 years; and

THAT, the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care give strong consideration to maintaining the inspection of small drinking water systems as a 100% provincially funded program; and

THAT, Ministers of the Environment, Finance, and Health and Long-Term Care, Acting Chief Medical Officer of Health, ALPHA, local Members of Parliament, local Members of Provincial Parliament, AMO, and all Ontario Board of Health be so advised.
