




Figures 3, 4, and 5 represent residents of Grey Bruce, who have received one or more doses of a COVID-19 vaccine, regardless of where the vaccine was received



GREY BRUCE COVID-19 VACCINATION OVERVIEW








Figures 3, 4, and 5 represent residents of Grey Bruce, who have received one or more doses of a COVID-19 vaccine, regardless of where the vaccine was received


Figures 3, 4, and 5 represent residents of Grey Bruce, who have received one or more doses of a COVID-19 vaccine, regardless of where the vaccine was received
