Meeting Summary

Date: Wednesday, June 16, 2021

Time: 1:00 pm - 2:00 pm

Vaccines Administered Update

- 121,415 doses of COVID-19 vaccine administered in Grey and Bruce, to date.
- Averaging administering +10,000 doses a week; 69% of those eligible received 1st dose; 14% received 2nd dose.
- 25 GBHU staff attended Peel Hub Saturday, June 12, to support implementation of mass vaccine system in hot spot area.

Recovery Phase

- Recovery takes months to move through but less intense.
- Goal is to move to sustainability of pharmacy and primary care providing vaccine, similar to other pre-pandemic community vaccine programs.

Vaccine Distribution Clinic Planning

- Data identifies Grey Bruce allocation in line with other health units.
- AstraZeneca coming for pharmacy/primary care clients seeking 2nd dose. Delivery will be week-to week.
- Larger shipments of Pfizer and Moderna expected in the coming three weeks.
- Provincial booking system limited to 1st dose only being resolved.
- 2nd dose intervals shortening with increased supply of vaccine.
- Process developed for clients to print their own vaccine receipts.
- Province developing process to register out-of-province vaccines, approved vaccines only.
- Expectation province will move to across the board eligibility for 2nd dose.

Resource Support

- Air conditioning installed at P&H Centre.
- Planning underway to re-locate YMCA Hub to various locations. Considerations include population needs, demand and resources.
- Will saturate Owen Sound with extra clinics before hub is re-located.
