MOH Update

Recent surge of Delta variant prompted request to Province for increased allocation to Grey Bruce; allocations subsequently confirmed

• Delivery of 25,000 doses a week can complete vaccinations in Grey Bruce by third week of July

• Immediate need for volunteers to support July 1, 2 clinics

Vaccines Update

- Finished 2nd doses in shelter/unregistered congregate settings cohorts
- Farm sector completed in Bruce; to finish in Grey next week
- 2nd dose timeline to be shortened to 28 days by Province; need to pivot hubs to accommodate
- Youth vaccines underway to ensure double vaccination by return to school in September; youth 2nd dose timeframe not reduced, as yet

Recovery Phase

• Upon completion of mass hubs vaccine delivery to return to pre-pandemic model of Public Health, pharmacy and primary care providing community vaccine

Vaccine Distribution Clinic Planning

- May 2 Province announcement of 2nd dose timeline prompted significant uptake; clinics fill up in under 24 hours
- Province to announce 28 day turnaround for 2nd dose; not know if this may be extended to youth
- Vaccine rates for youth, LTC staff and 80+ less than optimal; may require catch-up by dedicated mobile clinics

Resource Support

- YMCA Hub to relocate to OSDSS, target completion by July 12
- Single line hubs to be set-up in Thornbury and Bruce County
