





Figure 6. Doses Given in Past Week












Figure 6. Doses Given in Past Week

Figure 7. Cumulative Doses by Date Given











Vaccine Coverage by Age Group and Number of Doses Received








Figure 6. Doses Given in Past Week









Figure 5. Vaccinated Residents by Gender




Figure 4. Vaccinated Residents by Age





Doses Given in Grey Bruce: Past Week








Figure 6. Doses Given in Past Week





Figure 7. Cumulative Doses by Date Given



Current Situation:, <u>Public Health Measures</u>, <u>COVID-19 Vaccines for Grey Bruce</u>, <u>COVID-19 Vaccine for Ontario</u>

Follow the 3 W's – <u>Wash hands frequently, Watch distance (ideally 6ft), and <u>Wash face covering correctly, and the 2 A's</u>

- Avoid Crowds and Arrange for outdoor activities instead of indoors whenever possible.</u>

STAY HOME IF SICK

Case counts and vaccine data is taken from GBHU Epidemiological Reports as of 23:59 hrs, January 31, 2022: All data is preliminary and subject to change. Future situation reports will be updated accordingly.

- 17 new cases reported in past 24 hours in Grey Bruce:
 - Please note New cases reported are not an accurate representation of caseloads in the community due to recent changes in testing in Ontario.
 - o New cases only represent those that are eligible to be tested.
 - o Please practice safely to prevent COVID-19 at all times
- 5530 Confirmed Cases
- 156 active cases
- 5335 resolved cases
- 11 confirmed local active cases hospitalized in Grey Bruce due to COVID-19
 - 3 confirmed cases from Grey Bruce are hospitalized outside of Grey Bruce due to COVID-19 (These numbers are reported to Public Health by Grey-Bruce Hospitals on confirmed COVID-19 cases admitted for treatment attributed to COVID-19 infection)
- 25 deaths in Grey Bruce
 - +1 death related to a Grey Bruce resident that acquired the infection and was treated outside of Grey Bruce
 - +8 deaths related to Grey Bruce residents that acquired the infection in Grey Bruce however passed away outside of Grey Bruce
 - Local and Provincial data may not align as cases with unconfirmed cause of death are not included above but <u>are</u> included in the Provincial data.
- 409 cases reported in health care workers; reports health care workers living in Grey Bruce and working both in and outside Grey Bruce

- GBHU Team continue to ensure essential public health activities not related to COVID-19





Vaccine Coverage by Age Group and Number of Doses Received




