Figure 3. Vaccinated Residents by Immunization Status




Figure 4. Vaccinated Residents by Age




Figure 5. Vaccinated Residents by Gender




Figure 6. Doses Given in Past Week





Figure 7. Cumulative Doses by Date Given





Figure 3. Vaccinated Residents by Immunization Status




Figure 4. Vaccinated Residents by Age




Figure 5. Vaccinated Residents by Gender




Figure 6. Doses Given in Past Week





Figure 7. Cumulative Doses by Date Given

Figure 3. Vaccinated Residents by Immunization Status




Figure 4. Vaccinated Residents by Age




Figure 5. Vaccinated Residents by Gender




Figure 6. Doses Given in Past Week





Figure 7. Cumulative Doses by Date Given

Figure 3. Vaccinated Residents by Immunization Status




Figure 4. Vaccinated Residents by Age




Figure 5. Vaccinated Residents by Gender




Figure 6. Doses Given in Past Week




Figure 7. Cumulative Doses by Date Given






Figure 6. Doses Given in Past Week





Figure 7. Cumulative Doses by Date Given






