

## **GREY BRUCE COVID-19 VACCINATION OVERVIEW**

























Figure 6. Doses Given in Past Week



















Figure 3. Vaccinated Residents by Immunization Figure 4. Vaccinated Residents by Age Figure 5. Vaccinated Residents by Gender Status 3.000 100.000 85359 2.000 45525 50,000 1,000 Non-binary/third gender Prefer not to say 5957 0 2 Doses 3+ Doses 50 100 1 Dose

Figure 7. Cumulative Doses by Date Given




