COVID-19 Reporting

COVID-19 is a Disease of Public Health Significance under the Health Protection and **Promotion Act.** Probable cases that do not fit the criteria for testing are still required to be reported to the health unit as a probable case. Individuals who are being tested for COVID-19 should also be reported. Probable cases are advised to self-isolate at home for 14 days.

Swabs

NP swabs are preferred where possible. Nasal swabs should be performed for larger swab heads. The recommended process for swabs is to insert the swab until resistance is met, and twirl the swab for about 15-20 seconds. Throat swabs can be performed if patients do not tolerate anything in the nose.
