



Grey Bruce Influenza Bulletin (2019–2020) Epi Week 17 19-Apr-20 to 25-Apr-20

The data presented here are for Epi Surveillance Week 17, which is based on calendar year. It is the 35th Week of the 2019–2020 Influenza Season. Influenza Season starts at the 35th Epi Week of each year, near the end of August.

This report represents a snapshot of the influenza activity occurring in Grey Bruce at the time of Reporting and may differ from previous or subsequent reports.

Figure 1. Weekly Sporadic Influenza Case Count by Epi Week, 2019–2020 Season YTD

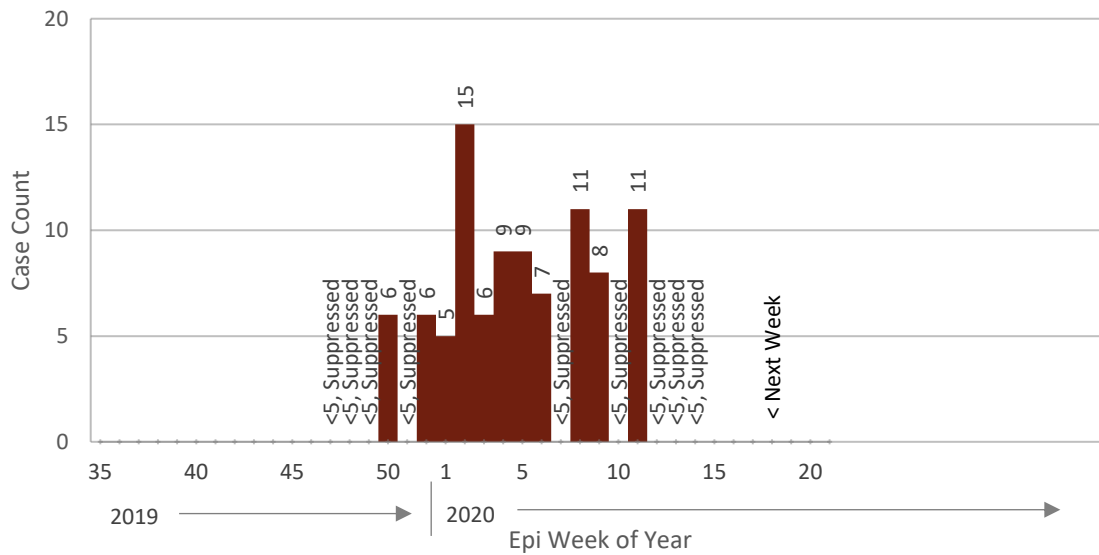


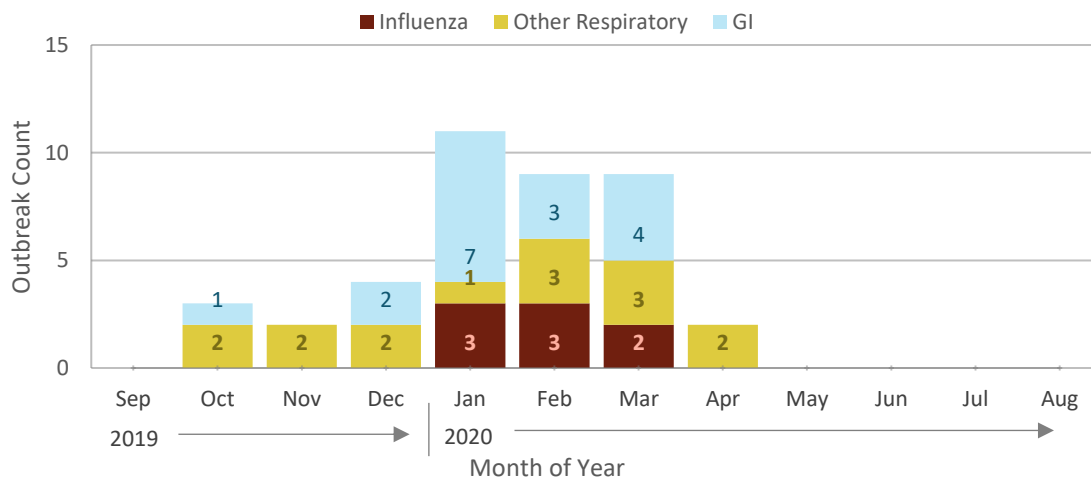
