GBPH notified of two cases of Q Fever in Bruce County in 2023

- Bacteria that causes Q Fever can survive long periods in the environment. Inhalation of airborne particles is thought to be the most common mode of transmission.
- Memo includes information on causes, symptoms, testing, treatment & prevention.

Rise in Syphilis and Congenital Syphilis

- In 2022, GBPH reported 27 cases of syphilis, up from seven in 2021 and 12 in 2020.
- Public Health recently investigated cases of unidentified and untreated syphilis in newly postpartum individuals.
- Syphilis can have devastating effects in pregnancy.

Encourage your patients to use ICON to update their child's vaccination record

- GBPH has developed a <u>one-page handout</u> with easy-to-follow instructions on how to use ICON, an online tool that enables parents to easily access and update their child's immunization card.
- Feel free to print this flyer, post it in your office, and/or distribute to patients.

Commercial tobacco cessation supports

- GBPH looking to restart Community of Practice for tobacco cessation.
- Public Health now offering STOP Program.
