Overall, Grey Bruce residents and

Ontarians are similarly likely to rate their overall health as very good or excellent.

VERY GOOD OR

EXCELLENT HEALTH

Grey Bruce residents aged 65+ are more likely than Ontarians in the same age group to report very good or excellent health.

FAIR OR POOR HEALTH

Grey Bruce residents and Ontarians are similarly likely to rate their health as fair or poor.

Grey Bruce residents aged 50 to 64 are more likely to describe their health as fair or poor than Ontarians in that age group.

SENSE OF COMMUNITY BELONGING


Grey Bruce residents feel a stronger sense of belonging to their local community than Ontarians.

This is also true of male, but not female residents, and of the youngest (12 to 17) and oldest (65+) age groups when compared to their Ontarian counterparts.

LIFE SATISFACTION

Grey Bruce residents and Ontarians are similarly likely to be satisfied with their lives as a whole.

Those in the youngest and oldest age groups, however, are more likely to feel satisfied or very satisfied with their lives than Ontarians in the same age group.
