


STRONG SENSE OF BELONGING IN GREY BRUCE

Grey Bruce residents overall feel a stronger sense of belonging to their local community than Ontarians.

This is also true of male, but not female residents, and of the youngest (12 to 17) and oldest (65+) age groups when compared to their Ontarian counterparts.

VERY STRONG AMONG YOUTH

Grey Bruce residents aged 12 to 17 are especially likely to feel a strong sense of belonging to their local community, at 95%.
