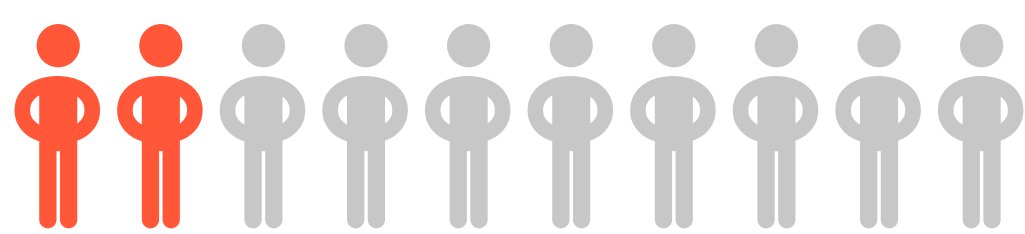


CONDOM USE

OF GREY BRUCE RESIDENTS USED A CONDOM THE LAST TIME THEY HAD SEX



LOCAL RATES LOWER THAN ONTARIO RATES

Overall, Grey Bruce residents are less likely than Ontarians to have used a condom the last time they had sex. This is also true of male Grey Bruce residents, and those aged 50 to 64 when compared to their counterparts in Ontario.

Male Grey Bruce residents are also less likely than male Ontarians to have had sex with multiple partners in the past year which may contribute to lower rates of condom use.

HIGHER RATES AMONG YOUNG ADULTS

Grey Bruce residents aged 18 to 34 are more likely to have used a condom the last time they had sex than those aged 35 to 49 and those aged 50 to 64.
