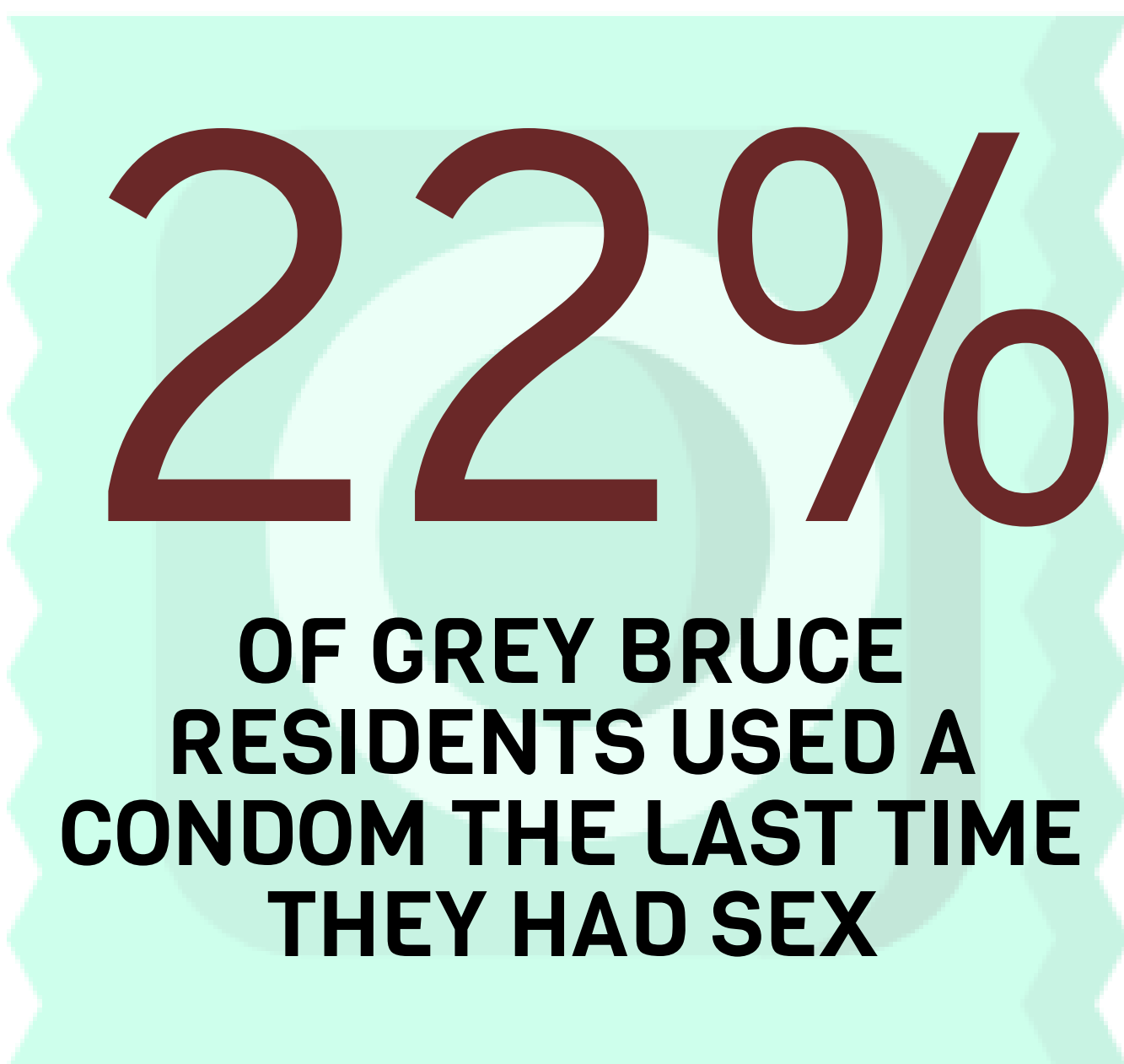
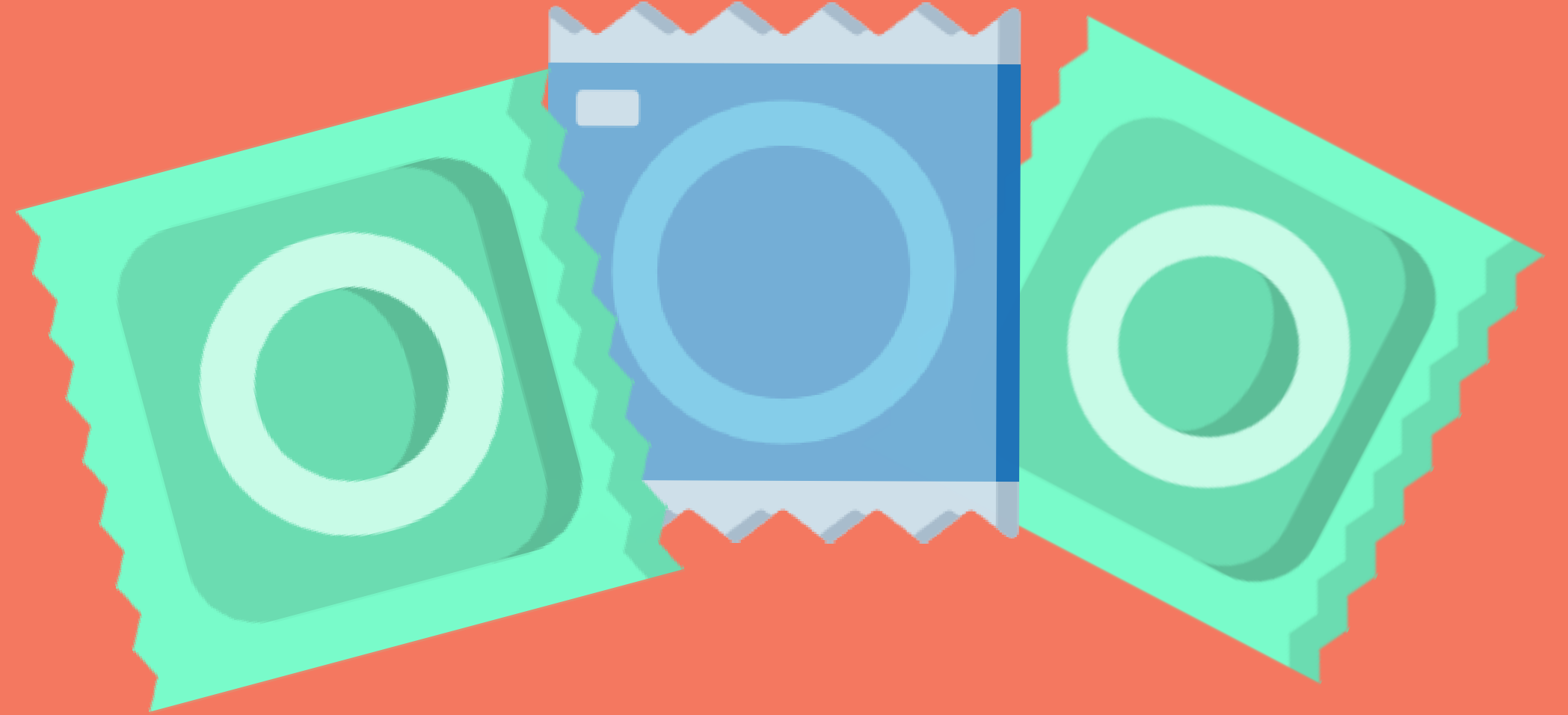

CONDOM USE

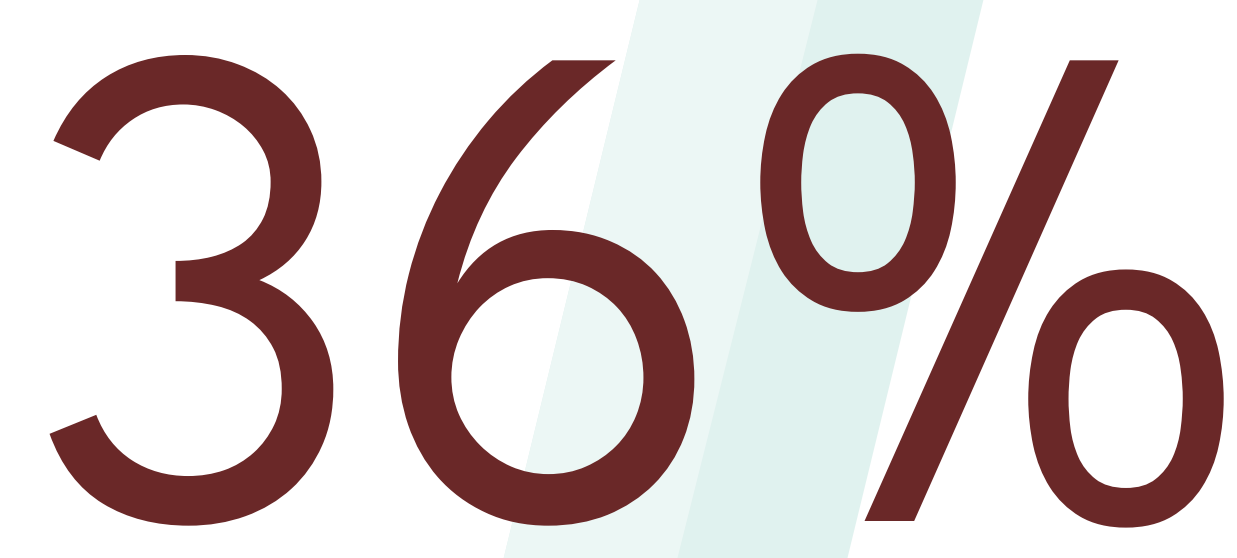
Overall, Grey Bruce residents are less likely than Ontarians to have used a condom the last time they had sex.

This is also true of male Grey Bruce residents, and those aged 50 to 64 when compared to their counterparts in Ontario.

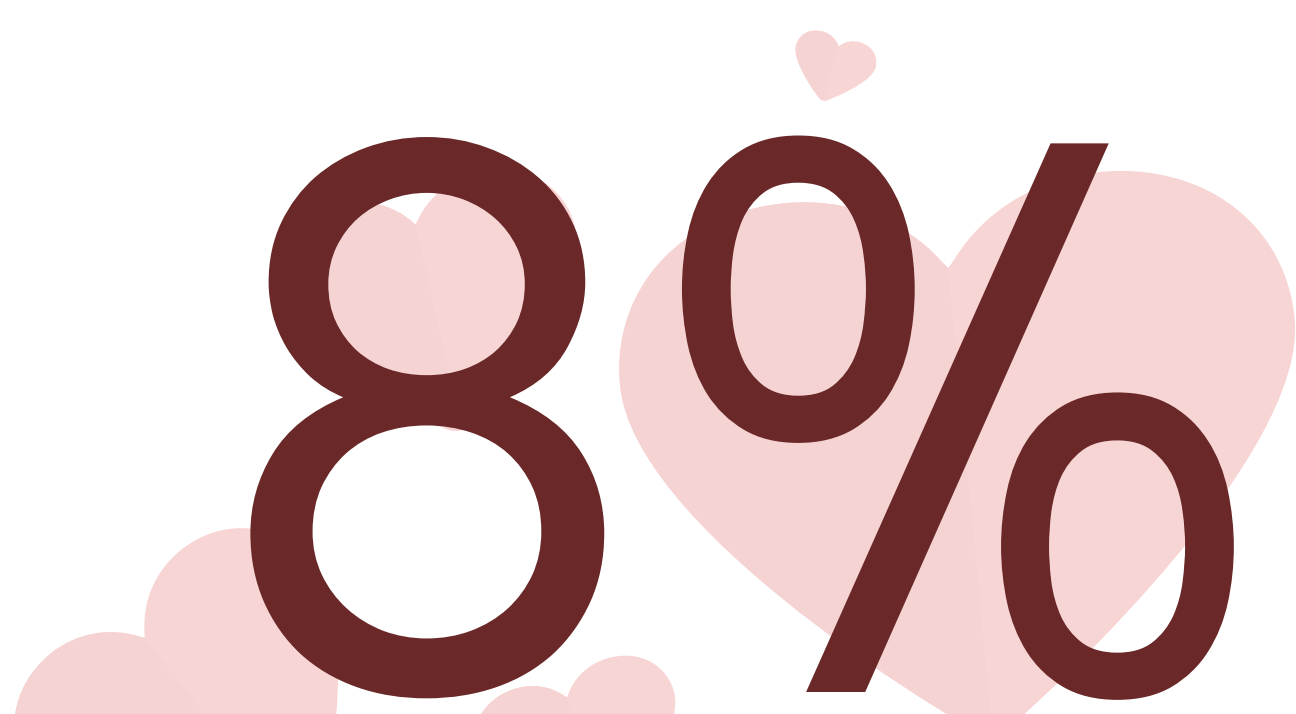
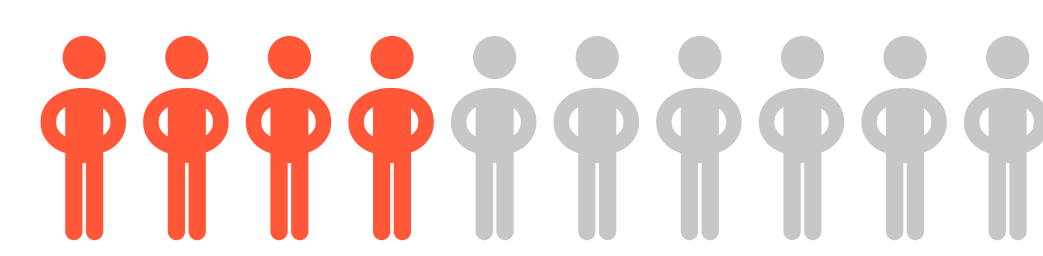
STI TESTING

Grey Bruce residents are less likely than Ontarians to have ever been tested for a sexually transmitted infection.

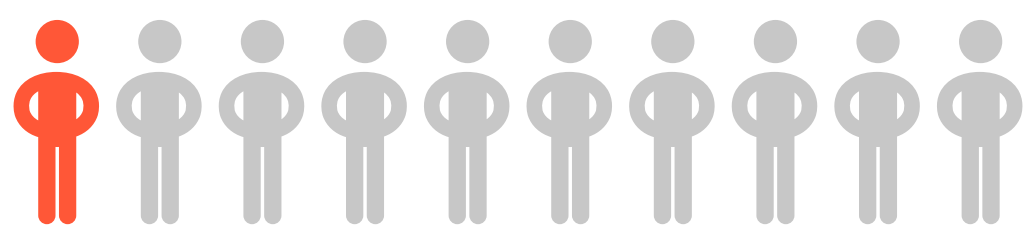
This is also true of male Grey Bruce residents when compared to male Ontarians.

OF GREY BRUCE RESIDENTS HAD SEX WITH MULTIPLE PARTNERS IN THE PAST YEAR*

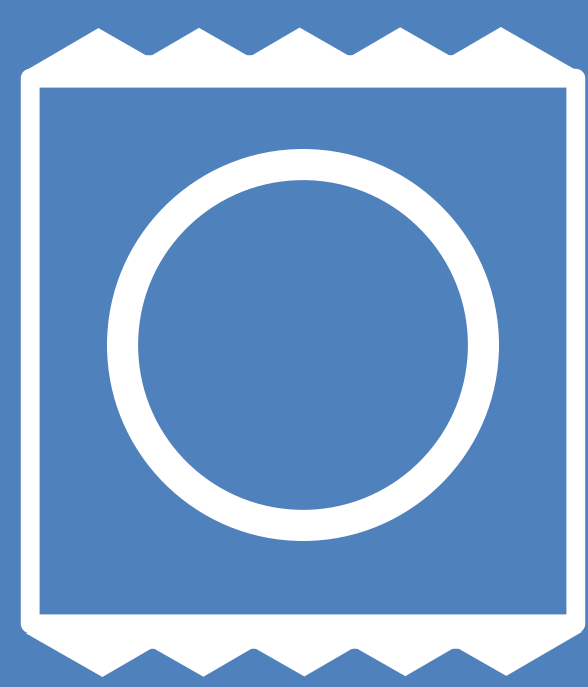


SEX WITH MULTIPLE PARTNERS

Grey Bruce residents and Ontarians are similarly likely to have had sex with two or more partners in the past year.

Male Grey Bruce residents, and those aged 18 to 34 are less likely than their counterparts in Ontario to have had multiple sexual partners last year.

Low rates of STI testing, particularly among males
