
CIGARETTES

17% of Grey Bruce residents smoke cigarettes either daily or occasionally, and 14% smoke daily.

Smoking rates in Grey Bruce are similar to Ontario rates.

OLDER ADULTS LESS LIKELY TO SMOKE CIGARETTES

Only 7%* of Grey Bruce residents smoke cigarettes (either daily or occasionally), which is low relative to younger age groups.

ALTERNATIVE TOBACCO PRODUCTS

Grey Bruce residents and Ontarians are similarly likely to have used an alternative tobacco product in the past month.

This includes little cigars or cigarillos, other cigars, electronic cigarettes, pipes, chewing tobacco or pinch or snuff, and tobacco water-pipes.
