OVERVIEW

The population of the municipality of Brockton currently totals 9,461, making it the 8th most populated census subdivision (i.e. municipality, city, town, township) in Grey Bruce. Brockton's population is on the younger end of the spectrum compared to other areas in Grey Bruce, with the fifth highest percentage of residents aged 0 to 14. Most of the dwellings here are occupied by usual residents (as opposed to seasonal or temporary residents).
