The population of the town of Hanover currently totals 10,749, having increased by 2.6% since 2011. It is the tenth most populated census subdivision (i.e. municipality, city, town, township) in Grey Bruce. Almost all dwellings here are occupied by usual residents (as opposed to temporary or seasonal residents).
