OVERVIEW

The population of the town of Saugeen Shores increased by 8.3% between 2011 and 2016- the second-highest increase observed in Grey Bruce over that time period. Its population totaled 13,715 in 2016, making it the second-most populated census subdivision (i.e. municipality, city, town, township) in Grey Bruce. Just under 80% of the dwellings here are occupied by usual residents (as opposed to temporary or seasonal residents).
