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OVERVIEW

The population of the municipality of South Bruce contracted by 0.8% between 2011 and 2016. Its population totaled 5,693 in 2016, making it the second least populated census subdivision (i.e. municipality, city, town, township) in Grey Bruce. The population of South Bruce is among the youngest in Grey Bruce.
