If the census subdivision is within the bottom 3 rankings for an indicator (based on either an absolute count or a percentage) the figures are coloured orange. If the census subdivision is within the top 3 rankings for an indicator, the figures are coloured blue. Ties in rankings are possible.

OVERVIEW

The population the municipality of Huron-Kinloss totals 7,069, making it the twelfth most populated census subdivision (i.e. municipality, city, town, township) in Grey Bruce. The population of Huron-Kinloss increased by 4% between 2011 and 2016, the fourth-highest increase observed in Grey Bruce over this time period. The population of Huron-Kinloss is on the younger end of the spectrum, with the third-highest proportion of children under 15 in Grey Bruce. Around 30% of the dwellings here are occupied by temporary or seasonal residents.
