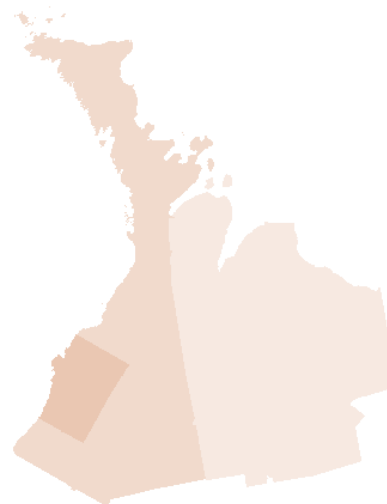


# MUNICIPALITY OF KINCARDINE

## 2016 CENSUS PROFILE

*The following tables summarize the 2016 census profile for the municipality of Kincardine. Indicators are provided with population percentages where appropriate, and **ranked against the 16 other census subdivisions in Grey Bruce** (excluding Neyaashiinigmiing and Saugeen First Nations, for which reliable census data is not available). If the census subdivision is within the bottom 3 rankings for an indicator (based on either an absolute count or a percentage) the figures are coloured orange. If the census subdivision is within the top 3 rankings for an indicator, the figures are coloured blue. Ties in rankings are possible.*

## OVERVIEW

The population of the municipality of Kincardine increased by just under 2% between 2011 and 2016. Its population totaled 11,389 in 2016, making it fourth-most populated census subdivision (i.e. municipality, city, town, township) in Grey Bruce. About 80% of the dwellings here are occupied by usual residents (as opposed to seasonal or temporary residents).
